

Kendra Tomsic:

Kendra joined the faculty twenty years ago after teaching at Highland High School, Grand County Middle School, Grand County High School, and the College of Eastern Utah. She received a B.S. in Physical Education from Utah State University, where she was class valedictorian. As the school's Athletic Director, Kendra attained Certified Athletic Administrator status in 1999. The College of Eastern Utah, where she began her collegiate experience, in 1996 inducted her into their Athletic Hall of Fame, and she will be inducted into the Utah State Athletic Hall of Fame in September, 2011. In addition to her administrative duties, she is the Upper School head volleyball coach and assistant softball coach. Kendra was elected and served as the 2004-05 president of the Utah Interscholastic Athletic Administrators Association, the first woman in Utah history to serve in this capacity. She was named Athletic Director of the Year by the UHSAA in 2004-05, received the State Award of Merit from the National Interscholastic Athletic Administrators' Association in 2006, was selected 2007 NCSSAD Southwest District Athletic Director of the Year, 2007 UIAAA Athletic Director of the Year, and was one of eight athletic administrators in the nation to receive a National Federation of State High School Associations Citation Award at the 2007 NIAAA/NFHS National Conference.
