Volunteer Opportunities Summer 2009

The Utah Museum of Natural History at the University of Utah is recruiting volunteers for the Summer of 2009. If you have an interest in the natural world, there may be a volunteer opportunity for you! Volunteers must be 16 years or older. Orientations will be held May 27th & 30th.

Public Program Assistant – Youth Summer Camp

Public Program Assistants help the Museum Education staff with the running of activities and projects for youth summer camps to include the set up and clean up of activities and rooms, getting supplies, assisting with snacks and bathroom breaks. General Volunteer Orientation is required along with a summer camp orientation. On the job training is provided.

Summer camp sessions run from June 8 – August 14. A commitment of a minimum of one full week session of 20+hours, (M-F) (two sessions preferred, of 40+hours), either 8:00-12:15 and/or 12:30- 4:45.

Anthropology Lab Aide

Anthropology Lab Aides help with the inventory and stabilization of objects in preparation for their eventual transfer to the new museum. This involves counting, cleaning and stabilizing artifacts such as ceramic sherds, pots, stone tools and perishables. General Volunteer Orientation is required. On the job training is provided.

A minimum of 3 hours per month or 3 hours per week of service is required. A three month commitment is also required.

Available shifts are on Saturdays once a month from 9:30-12:30 or 1:30-4:30 or once a week morning shifts from 9:30-12:30 or afternoon shifts from 1-4.
