

## **Rowland Hall Bus Rules**

- 1) The bus is a continuation of the classroom; all RH school rules and expectations apply to all students while riding a RH bus. Please see parent/student handbook for school rules and expectations.**
  - 2) Students are expected to follow the driver's and monitor's instructions the first time asked.**
  - 3) Students are expected to show respect toward adults, other students and school bus property.**
  - 4) Students must wear properly fastened seat belts.**
  - 5) Students are expected to sit in their seats face forward while the bus is in motion.**
  - 6) Students are expected to talk quietly, using appropriate language.**
  - 7) Students are expected to keep hands, feet and objects to themselves and inside the bus. Students must never throw anything out of bus windows.**
  - 8) Food and gum are not permitted on the bus. Students may eat a snack prior to boarding the bus.**
  - 9) Electronic devices are allowed while riding the bus but must be on silent or vibrate. Cell phones must be on vibrate and used only for an emergency.**
  - 10) No electronic devices or cell phones are allowed on fieldtrips.**

### **2011-2012 Bus Rules Acknowledgement**

**If a child is not following the above guidelines the following consequences will occur.**

The initial infraction will be an opportunity to dialogue with the student about their inappropriate behavior. The student(s) will receive a warning and be advised to change their behavior.

If the inappropriate behavior continues after the initial warning, parents will be contacted. Consequences for continuing and/or serious infractions may include On Reports, loss of bus privileges for up to a week, month(s), or year.
