Dear Parents,

Your student has registered to play tennis on the Rowland Hall team this spring. With all that is happening in the world, please be aware that all the information below is subject to change based on the fluid situation we are experiencing. Practices are scheduled to begin on **Monday**, **February 27** (weather permitting) and will be held daily from 3:30-5:00 p.m. at the **Liberty Park tennis courts**. Depending on the number of players who turn out for the team, a cut may be necessary, and tryouts will then be held the first few days of practice to determine team membership. The decision as to whether tryouts will be necessary will be made in late February and will be communicated to players and parents.

The UHSAA requires a physical examination be performed <u>each school year</u>. This means that you need to schedule an appointment *now* to have the exam done by a physician and the Physical Exam Form <u>A completed, signed and submitted to the Athletic Director by FEBRUARY 10 if you have not already done so (if your student has participated in another Rowland Hall sport already this year, you do not need to submit another physical exam).</u>

Several other forms are also required and will be read and E-signed by you and your athlete as you register them for Boys Tennis on AKTIVATE site (formerly known as Register My Athlete), that registration procedure outlined in another attachment to this email. **Registration** on the "Aktivate" site also needs to be done by FEBRUARY 10 or before. As mentioned, all forms except for the Physical Exam Form A and the Consent Form (part of Form A) will now be electronically signed by you and your student.

Other pertinent information about the program (match schedule, away site directions, etc.) can be accessed through your parent portal.

The mandatory parent meeting will be held **on Tuesday, March 7th at 6:00 p.m. and will be held via a Zoom meeting in that same time frame.** The coaching staff will share necessary information and answer any questions you may have about the boys' tennis program. At least one parent representative is required to attend this meeting for your student to participate on the team, even if they have played on our team in the past. If you are unable to attend, please contact me to set up a one-on-one meeting to go over the information missed. It is most desirable that you attend this initial meeting—even if you are a seasoned parent of the boys' tennis program—as new information will be presented, and policies reviewed.

I am excited for the season to start and coaching this newest version of the boy's tennis program, as well as looking forward to an exciting, successful season of Winged Lion tennis, and hope you will be able to attend many of the matches. I look forward to meeting you at the parent meeting
